

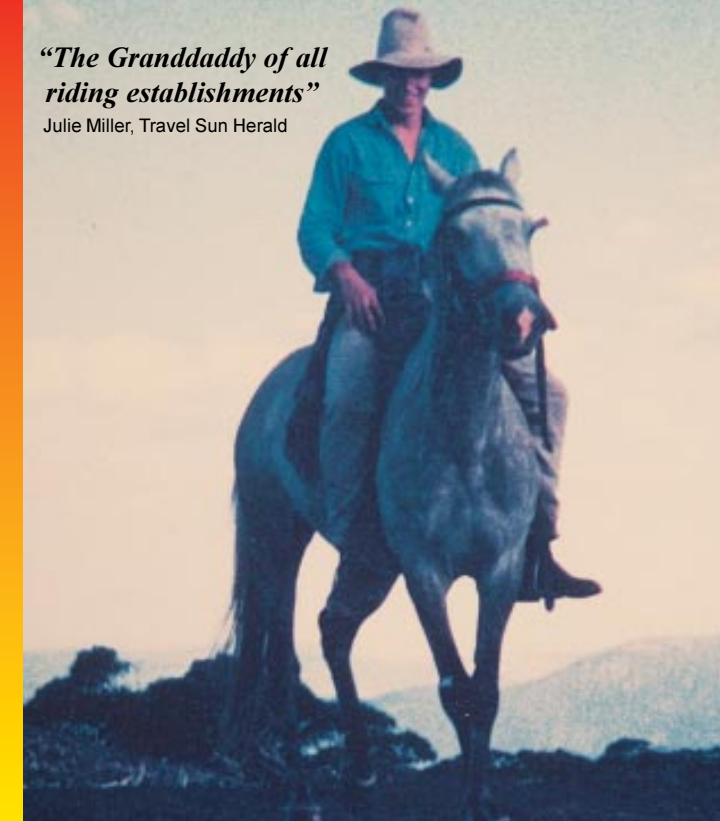

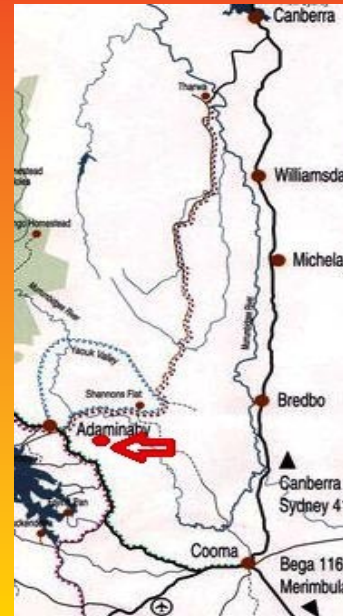
Directions - Booking Information

If coming from Cooma:

Come straight through Cooma, take the right turn onto Snowy Mountains Highway approx 9 km out of Cooma, continue 30 km until you see a large Reynella sign and Kingston Road, take turn and continue down Kingston Road approx. 9.5 km and turn left at Reynella driveway.

If coming from Tumut:

Come through Adaminaby and follow the road out of town, cross Locker's Creek and then turn left at the intersection. Go past the racecourse and take the first right. That's Kingston Road. Reynella is about 4 km up that road, and is right turn.

Horse Safaris - Kosciuszko National Park

Experience the unsurpassed beauty of Kosciuszko National Park on horseback with 'Reynella Kosciusko Rides'. In operation for our fortieth year, the safaris cover country that inspired Banjo Paterson's "The Man From Snowy River". Ride the land of mountain horsemen, brumbies, wildflowers and Alpine wilderness. We believe there is no other holiday like it!

Gaze from a mountain top at breathtaking Alpine scenery with its rolling plains, fresh, cool mountain stream, and carpets of wildflowers. The area unchanged by time has a wealth of nature's treasures, hidden caves and valleys and natural watering holes, just waiting to be discovered by you.

Experience the sheer delight of a dip in a crystal clear mountain stream only accessible on horseback, canter across the plains where wild bush horses roam, explore limestone caves and historic high country huts. Enjoy bush picnics, meals of mouth watering trout, steak, roasts cooked by camp oven, desserts and billy tea. At night sleep under the stars in our roomy tents on thick mattresses, contented and rested from your day in the high country.

What is the duration of your safaris?

We offer 3 day/4 night and 5 day/6 night Alpine horse safaris in Kosciuszko National Park.

When is your safari season?

Our safaris operate from November to the end of April

Do I need to be an experienced rider?

We cater for **all levels** of rider from beginner to advanced. All riders will have plenty of opportunity to ride to their ability in a safe and controlled manner. Our leaders offer guidance and tuition en route and we find that beginner riders gain confidence whilst the competent rider can refine their skills. As horse riding is a physical activity a certain level of fitness will be required. Reynella is proud of its ability to match horses with riders. All horses are bush wise with the strength and stamina to work in all terrains.

Are your leaders Qualified?

Our trek leaders are AHRC certified with years of experience behind them.

Where will we be riding and how much riding will we be doing each day?

Our Safaris cover up to 160km on a 5 day safari. (Averaging 5-6 hours of riding each day).

Reynella covers country in the Northern end of the Kosciuszko National Park. Providence, Tantararra, Currango Creek, Long Plain, 17 Flat, Jones' Plain, the Cherry Gardens, Murray Creek, Kiandra Goldfields, 4 Mile Creek, Broken Dam, Oldfields Hut and sections of the Cooktown to Melbourne Bicentennial National Trail. All rides are approved by the NSW NPWS within the Kosciuszko National Park Plan of Management and are supported by pack horse or 4WD.

Will we see brumbies?

Whilst we do not guarantee that you will see brumbies on our safaris we cover country where brumbies frequent and are commonly seen and photographed by our guests.

What does your package include?

D/B/B—3 course dinners with nibbles, full breakfasts, 1st & last night accommodation at Reynella Homestead, camping in KNP, tent, mattress, chappets, 3 or 5 full days horse riding, helmets, willing horses and Australian stock saddles (or all purpose).

What do I need to bring?

ESSENTIALS: Woollen jumpers, old jeans/jodhpurs, swimmers, long sleeved shirts, sun block and lip cream, riding boots or flat soled shoes with heels, towel, hat with chin strap suitable for sun or rain, torch, personal medication, sleeping bag or oilskin coats \$45 hire each

OPTIONAL: Bum Bag (can be purchased), gloves, leggings/chaps, pillow, pantyhose to prevent chaffing, musical instrument, saddle, BYO alcohol.

School Holiday Homestead Horse Riding

We co-operate closely with the National Parks and Wildlife Service in ensuring that the riding areas of the National Park have completely recovered from winter; and that the plants and wildlife are given a chance to grow in spring. Accordingly, our first safaris commence the beginning of November.

Throughout the year we offer special school holiday horse riding packages outside the National Park at our sister property "Coombe". These 3 day/4night packages are perfect for families, single mums/dads and children aged 7 and up, however we will consider younger children with riding experience. Reynella is an excellent place to learn to ride. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Where will you be riding?

On our Homestead packages you will be riding at our sister property "Coombe", a 3000 acre working sheep, cattle and horse property. "Coombe" offers spectacular views of the mountains and Lake Eucumbene. Our guests will join us each night at the homestead, where they will enjoy our delicious country meals and relax around the open fire.

What does your package include?

D/B/B—3 course dinners with nibbles, accommodation at Reynella Homestead, bbq lunches, full breakfasts and 3 full days of horse riding, helmets, chappets, willing horses and Australian stock saddles or all purpose.

Thinking of buying a horse?

Owning a horse can be a costly exercise so if you are considering buying a horse why not join us for a Homestead ride and test drive your ambition of owning your own horse - prior to outlaying money.

Lodge Accommodation



Reynella farm holiday lodge is a working sheep, cattle and horse property operating approximately 6000 acres of country, set in the foothills of the Snowy Mountains near Adaminaby, just 40 minutes drive from Cooma on the Snowy Mountains Highway.

Holidays based at Reynella Homestead provide a relaxing and friendly atmosphere of renowned country hospitality or a full on adventure!

Time is available for 1/2 & full day riding (dependant on safari dates) and an ideal base for exploring the magnificent surrounding area of the Snowy Mountains.

What is lodge style accommodation?

Clean, comfortable lodge rooms with shared facilities, (bring your dressing gown) all linen provided with electric blankets, towels, heaters, wood fire in common rooms, rooms serviced daily.

What is included in our rate?

Our rates include 3 course dinners with nibbles, accommodation, full breakfast, BYO alcohol (lunch if horse riding).

Do we have other facilities?

Drying room for winter ski gear, laundry, games room with TV and pool tables, common room with TV, informal dining / lounge with large stonewall open fire-place, tennis court.

Do we accommodate group bookings?

Yes we do. Organise a group booking for discounts on our advertised rate.

What attractions are close by?
